One stocking off and one stocking on. Did-dle, did-dle, dump-ling, my son John.

Ost. 1

"Ice cream! Get - cher ice cream!"

Ost. 2

"Ex - tra, ex - tra! Read all a - bout it!"

The origin of this song may have been a street vendor's call. I've suggested 2 non-dumpling street calls. See what else your students can create. Maybe a Fruit Roll-ups call would be fun!

The calls can be used as:

- Interludes between repetitions of the song.
- A cacophonous introduction and/or coda.
- Rhythms for body percussion ostinato patterns.
