A bit slower

1 Fed my horse in a pop - lar trough.

3 Should - 've used a dif - f'rent wood:

Optional ending or interlude

1 Cough, cough, cough! Cough, cough, cough! A - choo! A - choo!

♪ **Easy-squeezy:** Sing only the melody for the A and B sections.

♪ **Middle of the road:** Add either Voice 2 to the A section, or Voice 3 to the B section.

♪ **Fancy-shmancy:** Add the not-yet-added voice into its appropriate section.

♪ **F-Shm x 2:** Sing in AB form, ending with the simulated whoopin' cough. ("s.w.c.")

OR: Sing in ABA form, with the "s.w.c." as an interlude after B.
