This is the introduction / interlude. I recommend playing your guitar to accompany the singing of the verse and the refrain. Then the instruments take over.

After spending a class (or 2) learning these parts, you can use this as a round-robin game. Alternate jingle bells, barred instruments, and a resting turn (very important!); and let everyone move to the next space each time you sing the song.

Sleigh Ride (Leroy Anderson)

2 groups: sleigh riders, and horses

Introduction: Sleigh riders put on their winter clothing.

Each A: Riders, seated in the sleigh, bounce the steady beat.

Each B: Horses gallop through space. (Teacher indicates when it is time for the horses.)

C: Sleigh riders arrive at a festive party, and fun doth ensue.

(Groups must take turns, of course!)
