To really see the canon in space, try this movement:

Just walk through the space with the steady beat in your feet for the first 2 phrases of the song. But when you sing the last phrase, move like a chicken/rooster.

Let students practice in their own space first. (You'll thank me later!) After that practice, let them try moving through the space. What makes this so fun is hearing other parts being sung as you pass other people. And you get to see a lot of flapping and scratching, too!

Creativity: Consider letting students create an introduction. They might imitate an alarm clock or a striking bell, show the sunrise through movement, or any number of things.
