Since I use this with young children, I opt out of "right" and "left." Instead, I sing, "I put my hand in, etc." The next verse is, "I put my other hand in." Trust me, it will avoid some confusion!

For other verses, select different body parts. (Foot, elbow, etc.)

**Formation:** Circle, moving either direction you choose. After singing "night," face the center of the circle for the rest of the game.
